Volunteer Consent for Fingerprinting

A state law says people who work or volunteer with individuals with mental retardation and developmental disabilities have to be checked to see if they have a criminal record. **This is true even if you don't have a record.** The law was passed to protect individuals with MR/DD (and people who work with them) from convicted criminals.

The law also says you have to get fingerprinted. This is how the state checks to see whether you have a record. **We apologize for the inconvenience and appreciate your interest in volunteering with us!**

LONG TERM CARE WORKER BACKGROUND CHECK OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 5126.281 CONSENT AND ATTESTATION FORM

By signing this form, I consent to the submission of a request for a criminal records check for workers employed to provide care to individuals with Mental Retardation and Developmental Disabilities as required by Ohio Revised Code section 5126.281. The request will be submitted by Columbus Center for Human Services, Inc.

I also attest to the following:

1. That I have not been convicted of or pleaded guilty to any of the crimes that would disqualify me from working or volunteering with individuals with MR/DD under Ohio Revised Code section 5126.281. (See list on back)
2. That I understand and agree that if I am found to have a record of any of those crimes, I will not be hired for work or asked to volunteer with individuals with MR/DD or, if I have already been hired or accepted as a volunteer, my services with CCHS. Inc. will be terminated.
3. That I was informed that I must provide a set of fingerprint impressions and that a criminal records check must be conducted if I come under final consideration for employment or into the volunteer program.
